

Maplelane Golden Retrievers, Alliston, Ontario

Thank you for your inquiry into a Golden Retriever puppy.

Our dogs live in our house as part of the family during pregnancy and puppy rearing stage, which is where the puppies will spend their first 7 weeks. They will be well socialized with children and other animals as well as different sights, sounds and surfaces. Our puppies get the best in the 7 weeks they are with us starting with Early Neurological Stimulation from day 3 until day 16. We raise our puppies with the the Puppy Culture program outlined below, check it out !!

A healthy puppy with a sound temperament and genetics is our priority.

All our puppies will be sold on a non-breeding agreement and registered through the Canadian Kennel Club. They will also be microchipped and inspected by a Veterinarian a few days before going home. 6 weeks of free pet insurance is included with your new puppy. Each pup goes home with a booklet containing all relevant information on the history of your puppy as well as pictures, and information on the Jean Dodds vaccination protocol we follow. In addition, we also include a suitable crate, their first bag of dog food, and a first aid kit, micro chipping and CKC registration papers. There is also a mandatory 3 hour puppy training session on day of pick up. The total cost for your new puppy and all the training and equipment is \$2,500.00 and includes lifetime support.

If you are seriously interested, we will arrange for you and your family to visit our home and meet the dogs in person. During that time we will interview each other and be sure that we are comfortable working together. We will then chat about what you are wanting out of your dog and decide which litter/gender would best suit your family. A reservation is put down to hold your spot on the decided litter. Once the female is confirmed pregnant or if pups are already born, a 50% deposit is required to hold your reservation. Should you change your mind prior to picking up your pup, you will receive 50% of your deposit back or we will hold your reservation until you are ready.

Once the puppies are born, we will hold an open house every 2 weeks until the pups are ready to go home. It is important to attend as many as you can so you can watch the pups grow and to help with the socialization/imprinting process. We will also start an email group with all the families getting puppies in the litter and send regular updates via email.

No one picks out their puppy until the day you pick them up, so that means you will pick out and take home the same day. We do not allow choosing until after their vet check and we also want to see maximum temperament development before we choose. Each puppy will have a unique coloured collar since birth, so you will have the chance to track your favourite.

Choosing your puppy will depend on the order in which the families have confirmed their spot. For example; if you were the first family to put down a deposit for a male in a litter, you would then have 1st pick male, etc. This may be subject to the Breeder's discretion when it comes to working/show homes or if we do not feel you have chosen the right temperament match for your family.

On the day you pick up your puppy, count on spending 2-3 hours with us going over everything you will need to know to be a successful puppy owner!

Please note: crate training is a must.
